**OPEN:** Who are the groups of people who are most easily taken advantage of in our culture?

**READ:** Psalm 113

**STUDY:** Deuteronomy 24:17-22

- Who are the groups of people the LORD expresses concern for? Why would the LORD single them out as needing special attention in regard to justice?
- The LORD commands his people to "remember." What are they to remember? How does this relate to seeking justice for others?
- What does the LORD say his people should do to care for the vulnerable? What might this look like today?

**STUDY:** Isaiah 55:1-14

- Why are God's people complaining (v. 3)? What do they not see?
- What is the connection between religious practices (like fasting) and justice?
- What might vs. 6 and 7 look like in the church today?
- What are the promises the LORD makes to those who connect their religious practice with love for their neighbor?
